

When writing and Designing your site you need to have an idea of the structure that you will need, this will give you a guide to the size of the site.

One of the easiest ways to do this is by following Steps:

1. Have a Look on the Internet at competitors or existing site that you like the look of and follow a similar structure based on your needs
2. Draw up a simple Grid or Table
[You may want to use word or Excel for This]

3. Use the Grid to work out what you would like for Headers and the sub pages

Note: The Headers May Run:

A] From Left to Right across the Top

OR

B] Down 1 Side in a Column

Example [Left to Right across the Top 17 Pages]
